SECONDARY: Targeted cohort, young people with challenging circumstances and vulnerabilities. Often already victims or perpetrators of low-level anti-social behaviour (ASB). May already have received out of court cautions and/or be known to police and other agencies; TERTIARY: Intense cohort, complex and highly vulnerable young people. Already involved in serious offending, including those released from prison and youth detention centres.

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ABOUT THE YOUNG PEOPLE YOU REACHED

The following questions will ask you about the UNIQUE young people who attended your programme. Each individual who attends is a 'UNIQUE' young person .

How many unique young people have been supported by your programme in the last quarter (or holiday period, if you are a HAF deliverer)? (Required)

A UNIQUE ATTENDEE is counted once, regardless of how many times the young person attended. For example, if Ryan attended 10 sessions, you would record this as 1 UNIQUE ATTENDEE. If 60 unique young people attended sessions on 4 days, you would record 60 UNIQUE ATTENDEES.




